The Year at a Glance Planner

PreK, 4 Year Olds

This guide is designed to help you plan and see how the 4 year old curriculum is used in a 5 day a week program.

This bundle has grown and grown every year. I originally developed this for a two day a week program, but it has grown into a full week, learn through play, preschool program that has shown real student mastery. The fact that I am always thinking and adding resources to this program means you will get any future updates that are added after you purchase it for FREE!

The resources are perfect for a preschool schedule of 2-5 days per week. This guide will show you how the activities work for 5 days a week. But, this is easily adapted for 2 days per week.

This program covers the letters at a pace of two letters per week. When you teach in a 2 day a week program, that means you will cover 1 letter per week. When you teach in a 4-5 day a week program, you will cover 2 letters per week.
